



REQUEST FOR MEDICAID ENROLLMENT ASSISTANCE

The School Linked PAWS Community Adolescent Health Center is available to help families enroll in Michigan Medicaid Health Plans. Medicaid covers medically necessary services such as ambulance, chiropractic, dental, doctor visits, family planning, health checkups for children and adults, hearing and speech, home health care, hospice care, hospital care, lab, x-ray, nursing home care, medical supplies, medicine prescribed by a doctor, mental health, personal care services, physical and occupational therapy, podiatry, obstetrical care, private duty nursing, immunizations, substance abuse service, surgery, and vision. A yearly health exam is also provided. Some of these services are limited, and may not be covered for beneficiaries age 21 and older, or may require prior approval.

Although we are committed to helping all eligible families receive essential health care coverage ***parents decide whether or not they choose to participate.***
